ANNUAL PRIMACY FEE

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources Public Drinking Water Branch requires cities to charge an annual primacy fee to it's water customers. This fee will be added to the April billing. Ash Grove has less than 1000 connections so the fee set by the state is \$4.60 for residential addresses billed and \$16.48 for large meters greater than 1 inch but no more than 2 inches. The state uses these fees for testing drinking water, inspections, compliance activities, complaint investigations as well as technical assistance.
