SEWER FEE, SENATE BILL 741

Every year the City of Ash Grove is required by the State of Missouri to collect a sewer connection fee that is submitted to the state and deposited into a fund that was created for the purpose of protecting the air, water and land resources of the state called the "National Resource Protection Fund". The fee per residential customers is \$.80 and commercial customers with a 1" to 3.999" service line is \$11 and 4" is \$29. This ONCE a year fee will be on your JUNE water/sewer bill.
